Requirements:

- Poster size must be **8.5” x 11” and a 2-dimensional image.**
- Artwork must be original; must not violate U.S. copyright laws
- Each poster must be clearly labeled on the **back** with the following information: **Student Name, Grade, Teacher’s Name, School Name, Teacher’s Email Address, School Address, and School Phone Number.**
- Poster must represent the theme “**Upstream, Downstream....Clean, Clean, Clean**” by including a brief message and/or picture that represents what children can do to reduce stormwater pollution and keep our rivers and lakes clean. Image should be large enough to be easily seen and understood. Posters will be judged on originality, artwork, and message delivery.
- By submitting artwork, the artist grants CRWP and the City of Faribault the permission to reproduce and display his/her artwork. **Entries will not be returned.**
